Historical Facebook

- Location: The entire museum
- Supplies: Paper, pencils
- Find a historical figure from Arizona's history and make them a Facebook page. What would they post about? Who would they be friends with?

Dear Diary

- Location: The entire museum
- Supplies: Paper, pencils
- Pick a person from Arizona's history and write a journal entry from their point of view. What major events are happening at the time? Who are they talking to everyday?

Become a Curator

- Location: The entire museum
- Supplies: Paper, pencils, camera (if available)
- Step into the shoes of our museum curator and curate an exhibition with objects in the galleries. Pick 3 objects to display, write a short exhibit summary, and come up with a name. Take pictures of your objects and share your exhibits back at school!

Object Timeline

- Location: The 2nd and 3rd floors
- Supplies: Paper, pencils, camera (if available)
- Find 3 objects on display in the galleries and put them on a timeline of the territory of Arizona, (1863-1912). Make sure to include the date, a description of the object, and any additional information about when it was used or who owned it. Draw the object or take a picture for reference.
