


WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU VISIT THE

## INFORMATION

**Parking** is available in the Wesley Bolin Plaza, located east of the Arizona Capitol Museum. Buses may drop off students in front of the museum in the designated bus drop off zones located on 17th Ave.

Choirs will **perform** on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in the rotunda. There will be a monitor on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor with the schedule for that day.

## WHEN YOU ARRIVE

A Museum staff member will meet performers **OUTSIDE** the Museum at the east (main) entrance to review Museum Orientation before entry and will then lead performers to the performance area. Please do not bring your group inside the Museum until orientation has been complete. If you plan to arrive early and wish to free explore before your performance please call the tour office at (602) 926-3810 so we can arrange a staff member to meet you outside when you arrive for orientation before entry. After exploration please plan to meet back outside prior to your performance start time to meet with your Museum staff member.

# MUSEUM EXPECTATIONS

- Chaperones:* 1 chaperone per 5-7 students is expected. Chaperones are to stay with their assigned students at all times, and ensure students are maintaining good behavior in consideration for other performers and visitors at the Museum.
- Performances:* Are on the hour and end 45 minutes after the hour. Late arrivals are still required to finish by 00:45.
- Equipment:* A piano and speakers are available for use; if other items are needed, i.e. aux cord, adapter, etc., please contact us PRIOR to your performance and the Museum will provide if available.
- Post-Performance:* There is an option for Free Exploration of the Museum and activities that can be completed inside and outside in the Wesley Bolin Plaza. If you choose to explore the Museum please do so quietly as other performances will be taking place.
- Staff:* Museum staff will be posted throughout the Museum guiding performers to the performance area and out of the Museum post-performance.
- Admission:* Admission to the museum is always free. However, a donation of \$1.00 - \$5.00 per visitor is appreciated. All donations go toward funding museum exhibits and educational programs. Donations can be made at the donation box in the Museum Rotunda, through a Museum staff member, or online at [azcapitolgifts.com](http://azcapitolgifts.com).
- Additional Information:* This is a standing room event. Limited seating is available (on benches) in the North and South halls on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. There is no flash photography permitted in the museum, we do not permit food or beverage on the upper levels of the Museum, and blocking doorways or stairs is not permitted at any time.

***Please note: Due to scheduling constraints, we will be unable to provide late arrivals with additional performance time. Please arrive twenty minutes prior to your performance.***
